## SQUASH RULES - RECOMMENDATION TO AMEND THE RULES REGARDING SCORING.

With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2017 the committee are recommending that scoring in the Box Leagues and in future tournaments is brought into line with current England Squash rules. (See extract from England Squash rules below.)

## 2 SCORING

- 2.1 The winner of a rally scores 1 point and serves to begin the next rally. (American scoring "Point per rally".)
- 2.2 Each game is played to 11 points, except that if the score reaches 10-all, the game continues until one player leads by 2 points.

Matches remain best of 5 games with Match Points (6-1, 5-2, etc.) as existing.

For a review period (TBA) both players will need to agree to "Point per rally" otherwise the match should be played to 9 points as at present with points only scored when the server wins the rally.

For the record OSRA Division One Teams play "Point per rally" providing both players are in agreement - otherwise they revert to English scoring.

One point raised in committee was the fact that "point per rally" games could be very short where opponents may not be evenly matched – My personal view is that our box leagues maintain a healthy competitive edge thanks primarily to the inclusion of Ladder positions being taken into account for secondary promotion / relegation issues and for members returning to the boxes..
